THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK: New beginnings with Light, Life and Love

2020 is here -- the beginning of a new decade. This is not a futuristic time, it is real time that you and I are living with its concomitant new challenges, new resolutions and new beginnings. At the end of 2019, I received two inspiring messages as email attachments from two friends, one from Norway and the other from the USA. Both are nonagenarians whom I have known for decades. What is special about their messages is how both uninhibitedly acknowledged God's blessing despite the setback of age and diagnoses to the quality of their lives. Furthermore, both look keenly to the future with hope, a hope deeply rooted not in life's vitality, achievements or possessions but in God and His promises. He is faithful despite our unfaithfulness.

I believe it is appropriate and imperative to share one of the familiar quotes of the extremely influential lady: "We have nothing to fear for the future, except as we shall forget the way the Lord has led us, and His teaching in our past history" (Life Sketches, p 196). There is no need to be fearful of what may or may not happen in 2020. Jeremiah (29:11) reassured those of the nation of Israel who were taken into the Babylonian captivity, that despite their present predicament the story doesn't end there. God has an end game in mind: "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord. Plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." In 2020, we too can find hope in the same promise even when the reality doesn't seem promising. How God has led us needs to be remembered and reflected on — I believe the constancy and worthiness of God as revealed in the person of Jesus, is an irrefutable evidence of God's faithfulness.

My appeal to all of us living in 2020 is when the darkness of evil threatens our certainty of hope, let us be reminded that Jesus is light, life and love. He is the true light that brings hope. We too as Christians can be witnesses to the light, life and love of Jesus in so doing we bring hope to dark places in our world. As J. Welby frankly puts it, "For if you are in darkness what do you desire? You desire Light. If the darkness presses in from within you or without and menaces your existence what do you want? You want Life. If the darkness overwhelms your sense of identity, what do you need? You need Love. In our country, in our world light, life and love, bearing hope on their wings, are the gift we are given by Jesus Christ; they are gifts to be opened to all the world through our actions and words." May 2020 be a year when our words and actions are evidence of His Light, Life and Love.
